MAS/FPS Scholarship Information 2019

The Michigan Association of State and Federal Specialists (MAS/FPS) will award three state scholarships (\$1500, \$1000, and \$500) to eligible high school seniors or current college freshman. Selections will be based upon the NAFEPA Scholarship Application (National Association of Federal Education Program Administrators), which is attached. MAS/FPS will submit the applications of the top two Michigan awardees to NAFEPA for consideration for four (4) NAFEPA Scholarships of \$2500 each. (Please refer to the NAFEPA Scholarship information for scoring criteria.)

The full amount of each MAS/FPS scholarship will be made payable to the recipient's institution of choice. It is the responsibility of each scholarship recipient to forward enrollment verification and a tuition invoice from the institution to the MAS/FPS Treasurer, Sam Ewing. (Use the address below.) Please note that the scholarship is paid directly to the institution only after a letter is received from the institution verifying the student is enrolled.

Eligibility for MAS/FPS Scholarships:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior (Class of 2019) or a current college freshman; and
- Applicant must be attending (or have graduated from) a school or district that has at least one current MAS/FPS member on staff. (The scholarship committee will check the status of the district/school's MAS/FPS memberships prior to reviewing submitted applications.)

Submission Directions:

1. Complete the NAFEPA Scholarship Application and attach all required information.
2. Submit **one (1) original and one (1) copy** of the completed NAFEPA application packet to the address below by January 8, 2019.
3. Application packets must be **mailed directly to the address below**. No hand-delivered or emailed applications will be accepted.
