Greetings Pioneers,

As we get closer to the end of the year, I'd like to highlight some of our accomplishments as a school community. Teachers continue to meet in their Professional Learning Community (PLC) Teams to identify essential standards, create common formative assessments and refine best practices used in the delivery of instruction to maximize student achievement. The district has provided regular opportunities for teachers across the district to continue this important work and collaboration in addition to the work that teachers do on early release Tuesdays - which have been extremely impactful in moving the PLC process forward.

To build leadership capacity at the staff level, and increase rigor in the classroom to maximize student achievement, we offer multiple various professional development opportunities to our staff depending on the content and grade level they teach.

As we work to improve our climate and culture, we continue to implement Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS) and restorative practices. We also work hard to build leadership capacity at the student level by providing leadership opportunities for our young Pioneers to shine. Some of the opportunities include - but are not limited to- Link Crew, Student Council, Interact Club, Key Club, Model UN, PSAC, etc... Students continue to take initiative to make our school, city and world a better place.

The Principal Student Advisory Committee that was initiated this year currently has 26 student members. We meet on a monthly basis to discuss relevant topics to students and plan events to help improve student morale. For Arab American Heritage Month, PSAC student members have recruited the help of other club members to sponsor a three day Culture Days/Event to highlight the three regions of the Arab world- Levant, North Africa and Arabian Peninsula. I am extremely proud of these student leaders for the open and honest dialogues we have had. We have great ideas that we will continue to implement to make DHS a better place for all students.

In addition, we have re-introduced our Pioneer 6 Traits with the focus on one trait per month. Teachers have been implementing lessons and making reference to the traits - school wide- to help instill these values in our young Pioneers. The traits we focused on this year have been mindfulness, intrinsic motivation, accountability and critical thinking. This work will continue next year.

All in all, we had a fantastic year and look forward to finishing strong! That is the Pioneer way.


